

ACT OF THE SENATE

TO

BAN the usage of the Imperial Purple color from being used by vile plebeians and other such vermin

Be it enacted by HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY THE FAITHFUL PAVLOVIAN EMPEROR AND AUTOCRAT OF THE ROMANS AND ALL RUS', in the Eighth year of His Imperium and in the first year of the consulate of Princeps Christophoros Sclagamarus filius Drakon and Comes Eduardus Robertus filius Gundersovus, in the year Seven thousand Five hundred and twenty eight after the creation of Adam, by and with the advice of all Senators, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- I. The color Purple shall be restricted solely to the garments of HIM the Faithful Pavlov Emperor and Autocrat of the Romans, his August Spouse and his children, no one else may be allowed to display it in any form, that HIM Emperor does not approve of.
- II. The Consuls shall be allowed to wear a Purple badge on their outer garments with a Golden hand symbolizing their High office.
- III. HIM the Faithful Pavlov Emperor and Autocrat of the Romans, may by Edict, grant the right to the Purple color to companies as a symbol of Imperial approval.

The seal and signature of HIM Emperor Alexander IV through which Imperial assent to the preceding Act of the Senate is hereby given
