ACT OF THE SENATE

TO
PROCLAIM the infallibility of the Pavlovian Emperor

Be it enacted by **HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY THE FAITHFUL PAVLOVIAN EMPEROR AND AUTOCRAT OF THE ROMANS AND ALL RUS'**, Defender of the Faith, Turtle and Elephants, in the Eighth year of His Imperium and in the first year of the consulate of Princeps Christophoros Sclagamarus filius Drakon and Comes Eduardus Robertus filius Gundersovus, in the year Seven thousand Five hundred and twenty eight after the creation of Adam, by and with the advice of all Senators, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- I. Let it be proclaimed to All and Singular that the Pavlovian Emperor, by virtue of his supreme Imperial authority and status as the Viceroy of God, Emperor of the Romans, Successor of St. Peter, Defender of the Faith, Turtle and Elephants, and Custodian of Heaven on Flat Earth, when speaking *ex cathedra*, that is, when appealing to his highest authority and in discharge of the Monarchical duties, is preserved from the possibility of error, and the matters of State that he proclaims are possessed of that infallibility with which the Divine Redeemer willed that his Church should be endowed in defining doctrine regarding faith or morals.
