ACT OF THE SENATE
TO
BAN the Shaving of Beards

Whereas our Lord and Saviour through the Holy Scripture has commanded all the males not to shave their beards,

Whereas masculinity and intelligence are defined by the length of the beard, and

Whereas shaving of the beard was prohibited by the Edict of Ledjanoj Ostrov, dated 9 october 7522 (1 November 2014 according to the Calendar of the Heretics) –

Be it enacted by **HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY THE FAITHFUL PAVLOVIAN EMPEROR AND AUTOCRAT OF THE ROMANS AND ALL RUS'**, Defender of the Faith, Turtle and Elephants, in the Eighth year of His Imperium and in the first year of the consulate of Ducissa Helena Alexandra filia Kirsanova and Comes Eduardus Robertus filius Gundersovus, in the year Seven thousand Five hundred and twenty eight after the creation of Adam, by and with the advice of all Senators, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- I. Recognising that a male who shaves his beard voluntarily rejects his masculinity and commits an act of treason against the Almighty God, shaving of the beard shall be prohibited for all natural-born male subjects of the Empire, save for members of the Imperial Family.
- II. A male Pavlovian Rus' who shaved his beard shall be subjected to being forcefully castrated, stripped off all his titles, lands and deeds and sold into serfdom, if he be a nobleman, and being forcefully castrated, whipped 500 times, proclaimed an enemy of God, Emperor and Fatherland and exiled from this Holy Realm if he be a plebeian.
