

AN ACT OF THE SENATE

ТО

PROTECT the Pavlovian people from furries

Be it enacted by **HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY THE FAITHFUL PAVLOVIAN EMPEROR AND AUTOCRAT OF THE ROMANS AND ALL RUS'**, Defender of the Faith, Turtle and Elephants, in the Eighth year of His Imperium and in the first year of the consulate of Duchissa Helena Alexandra filia Kirsanova and Comes Eduardus Robertus filius Gundersovus, in the year Seven thousand Five hundred and twenty nine after the creation of Adam, by and with the advice of all Senators, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- I. This Act amends the Anti-Furries Act.
- II. Dressing as what is known as a "furry" be recognized as a criminal act.
- III. Identifying as what is known as a "furry" be recognized as a criminal act.
- IV. Sexual activity with relation to what is known as a "furry(ies)" is a criminal act.
- V. Association with what is known as a "furry(ies)" is a criminal act.
- VI. Violation of articles II, III, IV, and/or V will result in either surgical castration or burning at the stake at the discretion of HIM Emperor Alexander IV.
