**HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY THE FAITHFUL PAVLOVIAN EMPEROR, and
HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF BRIENIA**

His Imperial Majesty the Faithful Pavlovian Emperor and Autocrat of the Romans and all Rus' and His Majesty the King of Brienia, desiring to confirm by a formal act of mutual confidence the protective friendship which, in accordance with a happy tradition, the Kingdom has always experienced from the Pavlovian Government,

Considering that the interests of the Kingdom of Brienia are necessarily linked, by reason of its cultural situation, to those of Pavlov,

HAVE DECIDED to establish amongst themselves a treaty and to this end have appointed as their plenipotentiaries:

- FOR THE EMPIRE OF PAVLOV
 - His Imperial Majesty Aleksandr IV Feofanovych Faithful Pavlovian Emperor and Autocrat of the Romans and all Rus'
 - His Serenity Prince Krystofor Slavomyrovych Drakonov, Consul
 - His Illustriousness Count Eduard Robertovych Gunderov, Consul
- FOR THE KINGDOM OF BRIENIA
 - His Majesty Ivan, King of Brienia

WHO having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

Article I

The Kingdom of Brienia becomes an associated state of the Empire of Pavlov. Citizens of Brienia shall be eligible for Pavlovian subjectship.

Article II

The Empire of Pavlov undertakes to defend the well-being of the Kingdom of Brienia, its sovereignty in case of foreign aggression; if requested by the Government of Pavlov – to represent and speak on behalf of the Kingdom.

Article III

The Kingdom of Brienia, if requested by the Government of Pavlov, undertakes to provide support for the Empire; means of such support are to be decided by the two countries' Heads of State.

Article IV

Both parties undertake to:

- I. Implement a joint political, economic and cultural space, through eliminating border control for each other's citizens, creating a customs union, endorsing joint cultural events and taking other measures that the countries' Heads of State see fit;
- II. Respect each other's customs and traditions.

Article V

1. That the title of Pavlovian Emperor and Autocrat of the Romans and all Rus' is rightfully held by His Imperial Majesty Emperor Alexander IV of the House of Tezdzhah-Smahin and his legitimate successors under Pavlovian law, and that those who hold the right to the title of Emperor of the Romans are the Pavlovian Emperors and those they recognise as holding said right.
2. Recognition of other Emperors shall not mean a de facto or tacit recognition, but instead the "Emperors" in question are to be recognized solely as of the Caesarian rank, not as a Augustus.

Article VI

This Treaty is signed for an unlimited period of time, but can be terminated by both parties' agreement.

Article VII

The contents of this treaty are to be secret from foreign parties and or individuals.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned Plenipotentiaries have signed this Treaty.

Done at Harlemum on the eighth day before the Kalends of July in the first year of the consulate of Princeps Christophoros Sclagamarus filius Drakon and Comes Eduardus Robertus filius Gundersovus in the 8th year of the Imperium of Dominus Noster Imperator Caesar Alexandrus Augustus Censor Perpetuus, in the Year Seven thousand five hundred and twenty eight Anno Mundi
